With the intersections of High School Drive and Hwy 411 and Washington Dr. (Avalon) and Verbena Dr. (Arbors) being a priority. Total Project Cost \$59,959.12 includes local funds in the amount of \$11,991.82 - City cost. Motion was made by Council Member Nick Rutledge to approve. Motion was seconded by Council Member Matt Morris and all present voted AYE: Motion was carried by unanimous vote.

16. Mayor Lee – Consider approval to sponsor the Moody High School Girls Softball Team to go to the Regional Tournament in Albertville.
